

Terms and Conditions governing Qualifying General Practitioner Consultations:

1. The first 1,000 teleconsultations with a General Practitioner (“GP”) on HealthPass by OCBC (hereinafter referred to as “**HealthPass**”) shall be funded by OCBC (each a “**Qualifying GP Consultation**”). The appointment must be made on HealthPass and is only applicable for a user’s first-time teleconsultation with a GP.
2. The Qualifying GP Consultation is only inclusive of GP consultation fees, but excludes GST. For the avoidance of doubt, medication (including the delivery of the same) and any other products or services offered or provided by the GP (if applicable) shall be payable by the user and made through HealthPass.
3. Prescriptions of medication, issuance of medical certificate and issuance of referral letters are at the sole discretion of the attending physician.
4. Not valid in conjunction with other discounts, membership privileges, promotions or vouchers.
5. By purchasing, using or obtaining any products, services or consultations made available through HealthPass (a) you acknowledge and understand that HealthPass is developed, operated and maintained jointly by various third party providers; and (b) you agree that you have read and agree to the [Terms of Use](#) of HealthPass ("Terms of Use") governing your usage of HealthPass, which provide amongst other matters, that all products, services and consultations made available through HealthPass are not provided by OCBC but by Third Party Providers (as defined under the Terms of Use) under an independent contract entered between you and the Third Party Provider, for which OCBC has no responsibility.
